Oak – Wednesday and Friday



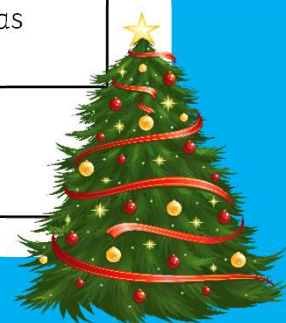

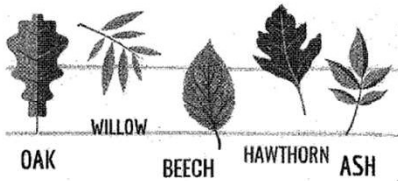

We raise money through fun events and activities, and there's always something happening.

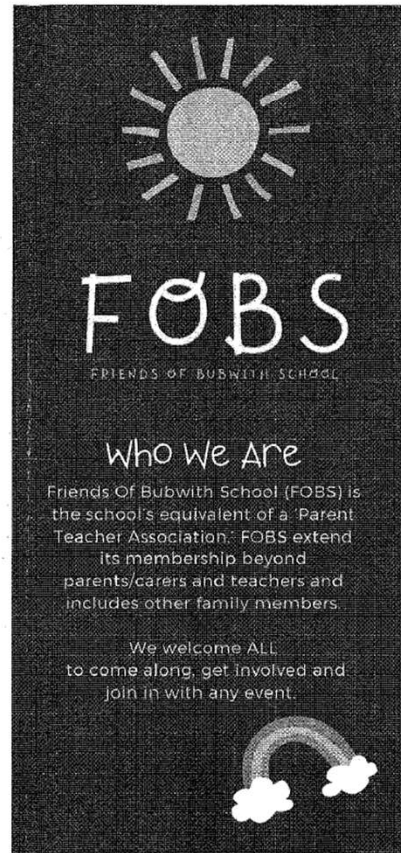
Our success comes from the support of parents and carers. Whether you give time, money, or skills, every little bit makes a big difference.

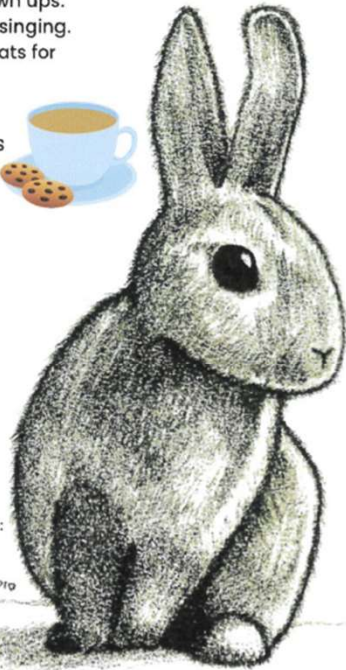
