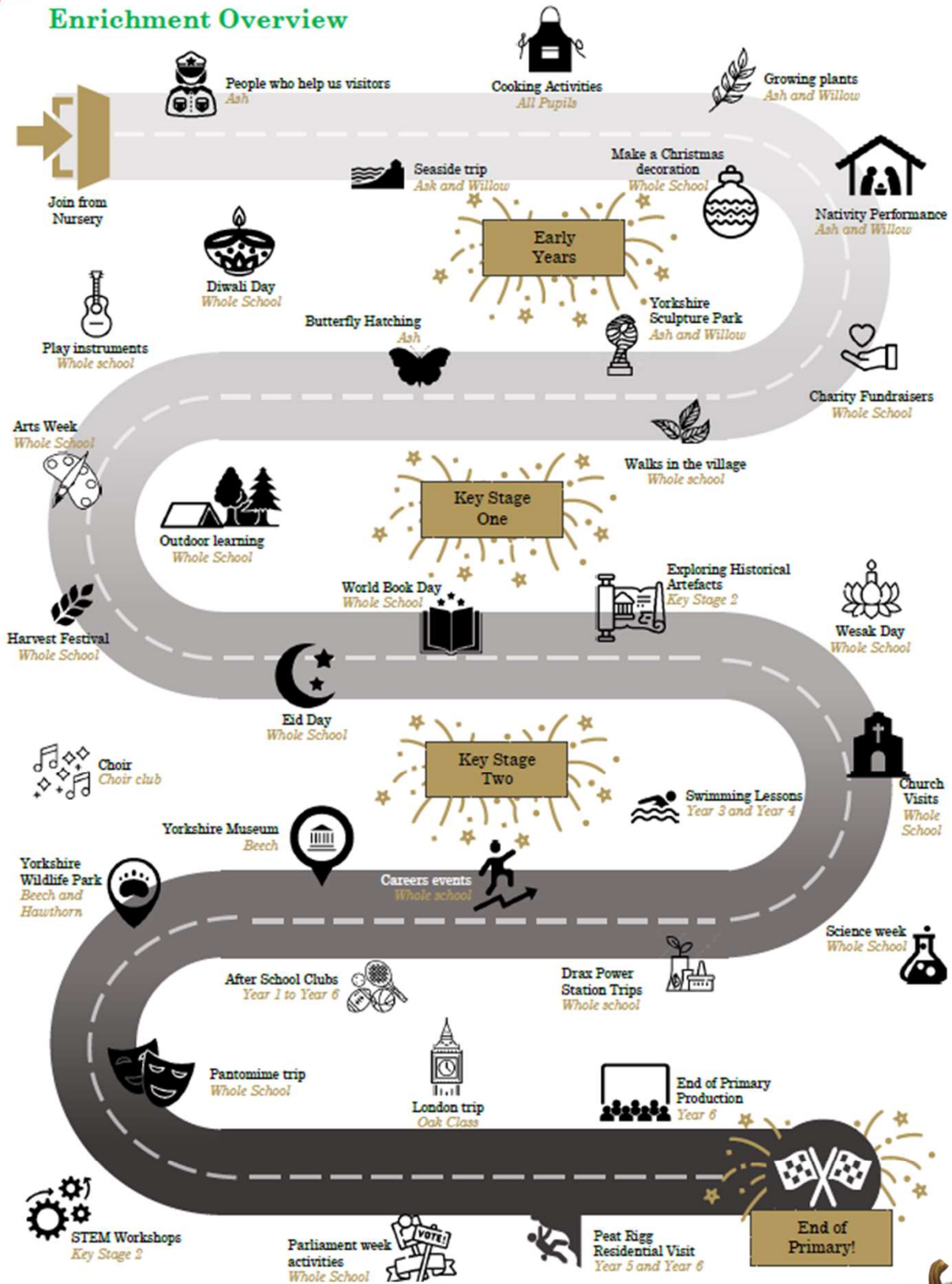
Cold Weather
